## GOVERNMENT LIAISON & EMERGING ISSUES REPORT

### Alberta Oil Royalties

The shadow billing period for Alberta oil royalties will continue until May 2007 (April production month). Until then, statements of penalties which would have been incurred will continue to be sent to operators via the Petroleum Registry. DOE Oil has requested industry input on a draft of the penalty waiver and appeal process.

### Pipeline Splits on the Registry

Pembina Pipeline and the Registry team are nearing completion of designing and building the systems required to implement full oil pipeline splits on the Registry. The first splits will be required to be filed by operators on the Cremona system in May 2007 for April production. For the first two months, Pembina will run parallel data collection using the Registry and the current FAX process. Once Cremona is successfully implemented, Pembina plans to convert other lines on their system until all of their pipelines are using the Registry. See the Registry bulletin board March 22 Registry Information Session presentation for more details.

With these changes both effective for April production, I thought I would pass on an interesting bumper sticker I saw recently: "Caution: Dates on the calendar are closer than they appear." Our committee will keep you informed either through the Recap or via issue-specific emails as more information becomes available. On **May 24, 2007**, TransCanada will be releasing a new software application to manage the Alberta System month-end process.

Starting with the **May 2007** reporting period (allocations due June 18, 2007), instead of submitting Receipt Allocation Forms (RAFs) through TransCanada Reporting, Production Accountants will begin using the new **Flowing Gas – Month End** application.

- April 26: 2:00 – 4:00 pm
